Basic Training On-Site in Oklahoma City

April 9-12 (Part 1) & June 18-20, 2019 (Part 2)

- Four days of PCIT overview with emphasis on CDI followed by 3 days (8-10 weeks later) of coaching and PDI emphasis
- Didactic presentations on the theory and techniques of PCIT
- Modeling and role plays of key parent and therapist skills
- Intensive skills training in PCIT techniques
- Hands on practice of skills with children
- Small group format with direct feedback from trainers
- Weekly phone consultation for 1 year
- Review and feedback of up to six video-recorded sessions
- Current PCIT Protocol (Eyberg & Funderburk, 2011)
- DPICS coding materials and manual
- Cost \$4,500 – PCIT Training only

Now with the add-on option of:

CARE Training

Additional 4 hours on June 20th

- CARE is a trauma-informed modification of PCIT
- Can be used by non-clinical adults who interact with traumatized children
- Materials and handouts provided
- No consultation required for CARE
- Cost - \$100
- Total cost for PCIT and CARE - \$4,600
